Dress Code

Off the course: Smart casual dress may be worn throughout the Clubhouse at all times unless specified otherwise by your host. Smart jeans/trainers may be worn in the Clubhouse at Bearwood Lakes, however scruffy/ripped jeans, tracksuits and football shirts are not permitted. Soft spiked and spikeless golf shoes are allowed in the Clubhouse: Lounge, Restaurant, Sports Bar and Balcony – please ensure they are clean before entering. Flip-flops and sliders are not considered appropriate footwear for men anywhere at the Club and should not be worn.

Caps should not be worn inside the Clubhouse.

On the course: When using the course or practice facilities, golfers should wear attire specifically manufactured for the game of golf. Hoodies, jeans, jogging bottoms, football/rugby shirts or training/cricket shoes are not permitted. All midriff should be covered. Smart/tailored shorts may be worn with WHITE sports socks which must be visible by 1 inch above the top of the shoe (a coloured trim is permitted for ladies). Men's shirts must be tucked in at all times. If choosing to wear a cap, this should be worn the correct way round. We are a non-metal spike club.

Yardages

Yardages are marked on the sprinkler heads showing distances in yards, to the front and the middle of the greens.

Halfway Hut

Open approx. 8.30am to 7.00pm in the summer (in line with daylight) and 9am to 2 hours before dusk in the winter. We offer a grab and go service including hot and cold drinks along with snacks including homemade sausage rolls, sandwiches, cakes and confectionery. Payment can be made by card or member account (no cash). We request that you keep your stay at the hut brief, to keep your round time down.

Etiquette

Please take care of our golf course as you would your own; so please repair pitchmarks on the greens and replace divots on the fairways and in the rough. Please keep your trolley/buggy out of the native rough and away from the greens. From the end of October until the end of March winter wheels may be used on your trolley. Bunkers MUST be raked after leaving the hazard.

Slow Play

A 4-ball should take no longer than 4 hours and 10 minutes.

Mobile Phones

Please refrain using mobile phones on the course unless in an emergency. Use in the Clubhouse should be restricted to text and internet browsing. Voice calls should not be taken inside the Clubhouse.

Directions

From the M3

Exit Junction 3 and take the A322 to Bracknell. Follow signs through Bracknell towards the M4 and Reading. Join the A329(M) towards Reading and exit at the Winnersh Triangle (also sign posted Park & Ride, Multiplex Cinema and Woodley). Then follow directions as *From The M4, as shown below.

From The M4

Exit at Junction 10 and take the A329(M) towards Reading. Take first exit at Winnersh Triangle (also sign posted Park & Ride, Multiplex Cinema and Woodley). *Follow signs towards Wokingham on A329. Turn right at the main crossroads and traffic lights by Sainsbury's. Turn left at mini roundabout into Bearwood Road. Pass Walter Arms Pub and Church on left. Bearwood Lakes is 300 yards on right.
